*Online students choosing the Pastoral Care focus area complete their programs as on-campus students, and, consequently, will not finish online. Normally, these students complete the six theological core courses, LIM 849, and two electives online. This focus choice may not be feasible for all online students. Students considering the Pastoral Care focus area need to assess their ability to complete the four required courses. Students who choose this focus area need to be able to complete the equivalent of the two required counseling courses (*Counseling Theories* and *Counseling Practice*) from an accredited graduate program in their local area, if on-campus work is not possible for them during a regular fall semester at Loyola University New Orleans. Students also need to come on campus for a two-week summer session to complete the *Introduction to Pastoral Care and Counseling* course. The fourth course in this focus area requires one unit of Clinical Pastoral Education from an accredited site. Not all cities or states have accredited sites.
